Do not count Power-play or shorthanded situations – **even strength 5 on 5 only.**

A “Checking Opportunity” (mark with a check in the box above by period) occurs only **after** the puck is shot into the defensive zone by them from outside our blueline, and we are pursuing the puck. If we win the puck insert the number of the player who wins it above “We Win the Puck” when we get 100% control of the puck in the defensive zone, even for an instant, not outside the defensive zone. It doesn’t matter how we win the puck.
