Do not count Power-play or shorthanded situations – **even strength 5 on 5 only.**

A “Checking Opportunity” (mark with a check in the box above by period) occurs only **after** the puck is carried into our Dzone by them and we are pursuing their player with the puck. If we win the puck insert the number of the player who wins the puck. “We Win the Puck” when we get 100% control of the puck in our Dzone, even for an instant, not outside the Dzone. It doesn’t matter how we win the puck.

If they shoot and we win the puck, mark as a puck win for us.

**Circle our marked checking opportunity if they score, and if they only get a shot, mark an “S” beside our check mark opportunity.**
