Do not count Power-play or shorthanded situations – **even strength 5 on 5 only.**

A “Forechecking Opportunity” (mark with a check in the box above by period) occurs only **after** the puck is in their zone after a dump and chase, when nobody has possession, or when they have possession and we are pursuing their player with the puck. If we have a forward line change, do not count as opportunity.

If we win the puck (insert player number) and then lose the puck, another forechecking attempt should be recorded with a check mark if the puck remains in their zone, either with them or loose.

“We Win the Puck” is when we get 100% control of the puck in their zone, even for an instant, not outside their zone. It doesn’t matter how we win the puck: we can steal it, they can fumble it to us or pass it to us in their zone etc. **Circle the player’s number if we score on the sequence after his win, and if we only get a shot insert the player’s number with an “S” beside it.**
